PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER
(POTTERY PARK, DEARHAM, MARYPORT)

ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014

Allerdale Borough Council being satisfied on reasonable grounds that the activities carried out or likely to be carried out in a public space:

- (i) have had, or are likely to have a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality;
- (ii) is or is likely to be persistent or continuing in nature;
- (iii) is or is likely to be, unreasonable; and
- (iv) justifies the restriction imposed.

has this 10th July 2015 made this Public Spaces Protection Order for 3 years in respect of the land mentioned in Schedule 1, which places restrictions as contained in Schedule 2 on users of that land.

SCHEDULE 1

Land at the Pottery Park, Dearham, Maryport, Cumbria edged red on the attached plan

SCHEDULE 2

No person who is in charge of a dog shall take onto, or permit that dog to enter or to remain on, any land detailed in Schedule 1 above without it being on a lead unless

- (a) he has reasonable excuse for doing so;
- or
- (b) the owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally or specifically) to his doing so

PENALTY

Failure to comply with the notice is an offence and a person guilty of such an offence is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
