Notice is hereby given in accordance with the above Regulations that Allerdale Borough Council has submitted the pre-submission Allerdale Local Plan (part one) to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government on 23 October 2013 for independent examination.

The Allerdale Local Plan (part one) will set out the spatial vision, objectives and strategy, as well as development management policies and amendments to the adopted Proposals Map, for the area outside the National Park.

The Pre-submission Local Plan and the schedule of proposed modifications, together with the supporting documentation submitted to the Secretary of State are available to view and download on the Allerdale website www.allerdale.gov.uk/localplan
