

## **Data assessment for Workington Towns Fund area – Ward breakdown**

*(All data taken from Cumbria Intelligence Observatory - <https://www.cumbriaobservatory.org.uk/>)*

### **Summary of ward breakdown according to theme**

#### **Population**

- There is generally a fairly even split in the male/female population across all wards
- The highest proportion of those aged 65 and over is in Harrington (25.3%) and St. John's (24.5%)
- There is a higher proportion of those aged 0-15 years in Moss Bay (22.4%) and Moorclose (20.8%)

#### **Country of Birth**

- In all wards, more than 95% of the population were born in England, with around 1% from EU countries

#### **Ethnicity**

- In all wards, except for St. Michael's, more than 99% of the population is white
- St. Michael's is slightly more diverse with: 2.8% of minority ethnicity; 0.9% of Asian/Asian British ethnicity; 0.5% of the ward population from mixed/multiple ethnic groups; 0.1% of Black/African/Caribbean/Black British ethnicity and 0.1% from other ethnic groups

#### **Main language**

- St. Michael's has the lowest percentage of people who have English as their main language (although this is still high at 98.7%)

#### **Marital and Civil Partnership Status**

- Moss Bay has the lowest number of residents who are married (37.2%), with Harrington having the highest (58%).
- Harrington having the lowest percentage (23.1%) of those who are single and Moss Bay having the highest (37.4%)
- Across the wards, those registered in a same-sex civil partnership varies between 0% (St. John's) and 0.4% (Moss Bay)

- Perhaps reflective of Allerdale's super-ageing population, the number of residents who are widowed or a surviving partner from a same-sex civil partnership ranges from 8.5% in Moorclose and St. Michael's to 10.2% in Harrington

## **Religion**

- The majority of residents are Christian (the lowest percentage is in Moss Bay at 74.7%, with the highest in Harrington at 82.3%)
- Harrington has the lowest percentage of residents who do not have a religion (10.8%) with Moss Bay having the highest at 18.4%

## **Qualifications**

- Harrington has the lowest number of people with no qualifications (22.7%) with Moss Bay having the highest (42.6%)
- Moss Bay has the lowest number of people undertaking apprenticeships (3.9%) with Harrington having the highest (7.6%)
- Level 4 and above qualifications (which includes degrees, higher degrees, NVQ Level 4-5, HNC and HND) are highest in Harrington (24.3%) and lowest in Moss Bay (6.5%)
- 'Other qualifications' (vocational/work-related and foreign) are fairly similar across all wards, ranging from 3.1% in St. Michael's to 4% in St. John's

## **Self-Reported Health**

- The highest percentages who reported as being in very bad health are resident in Harrington and Moss Bay (both 2.1%)
- Those who reported themselves as being in very good health live in Moss Bay (37.9%) and St. John's (44.9%)

## **Day-to-day activity**

- Moss Bay ward had the highest percentage of those who said that their day-to-day activities were limited a lot (15.1%)
- St. John's ward had the highest percentage of those who said that their day-to-day activities were not limited (79.5%)

## **Housing ownership and tenancy**

*Please note that in this section, the total figures add up to more than 100% in all wards. Cumbria Intelligence Observatory confirmed that this is due to the categories not being mutually exclusive which may lead to some double counting*

- The lowest number of owner occupied homes is in Moss Bay (20%) with the highest in Harrington (48.4%) and St. Michael's (61.3%)
- Shared ownership is low across all wards (0.1%-1.4%), with the exception of St. Michael's (16.1%)

## **Crime**

- The crime data is presented as crimes per 1,000 rather than as a percentage. The data below summarises the lowest and highest occurrences in the wards for certain crimes:
  - Anti-social behaviour – Harrington (11.8), St. Michael's (61.3)
  - Burglary – Harrington (2.6), St. Michael's (16.1)
  - Criminal damage and arson – Harrington (9.4), St. Michael's (37.9)
  - Drugs – Harrington (1.2), St. John's (9.5)
  - Public order – Harrington (9.1), St. Michael's (23.8)
  - Shoplifting – Harrington (0.9), St. Michael's (22.6)
  - Violence and sexual offences – Harrington (28.8), St. Michael's (89.1)
  - Violent crime – Harrington (7.1), St. John's (28)
  - Public disorder and weapons – Moss Bay (1.6), St. John's (8.8)

## **Households in fuel poverty**

- This data ranges from 8.9% in Harrington to 17.1% in Moss Bay

## **Children living in low income families**

- This is reported as 7.8% in Harrington and 8.6% in St. John's. It then rises to 18.5% in St. Michael's, 22.3% in Moorclose and 30.4% in Moss Bay

## **Index of multiple deprivation**

- This looks at seven domains: income; employment; education; skills and training; health and disability; crime; barriers to housing services; and the living environment
- Moorclose and Moss Bay are wholly within Deciles 1 and 2 (the most deprived)
- St. John's is the ward with the biggest variation – 25% (Decile 2), 25% (Decile 4), 25% (Decile 7) and 25% (Decile 8)
- There are no wards within Deciles 9 and 10 (the least deprived)

## **Economic activity by type**

- Moss Bay has the lowest number of residents employed full time (30.9%); the highest percentage is within the St. John's ward (43.5%)
- Harrington has the lowest number of people employed part-time (15.3%) with Moorclose having the highest (19%)
- Moorclose has the lowest number of self-employed people (4.2%), with Harrington having the most (7.8%)
- Harrington has the lowest unemployment levels (3%), with Moss Bay having the highest (8%)
- The student population across all wards is generally low (1.9%-2.5%)
- Harrington has the highest number of retired people (22.5%), with St. Michael's having the lowest (14.8%)

## **Long-term unemployed**

- Harrington has the lowest number of residents who are long-term unemployed (1%), with Moss Bay having the highest (3%)
- 0.3% of people in Harrington have never worked, compared with 1.6% in Moss Bay

## **Number of cars/vans per household**

- 12% of people in Harrington do not have a car/van, compared to 22% in St. John's, 35.4% in Moorclose, 37.4% in St. Michael's and 41% in Moss Bay

## **Living Environment deprivation**

- The indicators fall into two sub-domains. The 'indoors' living environment measures the quality of housing; while the 'outdoors' living environment contains measures of air quality and road traffic accidents

- Harrington ward is varied – 50% is within Decile 3, with 50% in Decile 8
- St. John's is also varied – 50% in Decile 1 (which is the most deprived), 25% in Decile 3 and 25% in Decile 8
- St. Michael's has 66.6% within Decile 1 (most deprived) and 33.3% within Decile 8
- Moorclose and Moss Bay both have 33.3% within Decile 10 (the least deprived)
