Subject matter and area covered

Allerdale Borough Council has prepared the Allerdale Borough Council Local Plan (Part 2) Pre Submission Draft DPD for submission to the Secretary of State. The Plan sets out the spatial planning and policy framework for the Borough of Allerdale (excluding the Lake District National Park) up to 2029.

The Local Plan (Part 1) identified a need for 5,741 houses and 54 hectares of employment land by 2029 across the district. The role of the Local Plan (Part 2) is to identify the land that will deliver this growth for: housing; employment; retail; Gypsy and Travellers and Travelling Showpeople; wind energy and open space and green infrastructure. The Local Plan (Part 2) also includes a number of policies to help deliver the identified level of growth sustainably.

Representations are invited on the Local Plan for a period of six weeks beginning on Friday 5th October 2018. Representations should be made on the standard representations form and returned to the address or email address below, not later than 4pm Friday 16th November 2018. The use of the standard representations form is strongly recommended as this will ensure that comments are related to matters relevant to the subsequent examination by a planning inspector.
