Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulation 16 & 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 notice is given that Allerdale Borough Council formally adopted the Cumbria Wind Energy Supplementary Planning Document on the 23rd January 2008.

The Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was produced by Cumbria County Council to interpret and provide guidance on planning policies dealing with the development of onshore wind turbines and their associated landscape impact. It has been adopted by Allerdale Borough Council to form part of the borough's Local Development Framework (LDF).

Any person aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the adoption of the SPD. Any application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
